## **Pat Cardinell Memorial Scholarship**

PURPOSE: To support sea cadets to further their education by attending post-secondary

studies in either law enforcement or maritime studies.

BACKGROUND: This scholarship is administered by the Navy League of Canada – Vancouver

Island Division and is donated in memory of Lt(N) Kenneth Patrick (Pat) Cardinell, CD a retired Vancouver City Police officer and a serving member of the Cadet Instructor Cadre (CIC) at the time of his passing on 17-Dec-2013. Lt(N) Cardinell completed over 32 years of dedicated service to the Canadian Cadet organizations. His activities spanned six cadet corps and two cadet summer training centres. With extensive experience training cadets on the 300-class YAG sea training vessels, he was the first CIC Officer to qualify to be the OiC of the

Orca class patrol craft trainer.

CRITERIA: The scholarship is available to any deserving sea cadet from Vancouver Island

Division or BC Mainland Division and is awarded on the basis that the cadet will be pursuing post-secondary studies in either law enforcement or maritime studies.

**RESTRICTIONS:** Applicant must be a sea cadet with minimum of 3 years' service and is in their last

year of cadets or has aged out in the last year and are pursuing post-secondary

studies in either law enforcement or maritime studies.

AMOUNT: \$500

**BENEFACTOR:** Friends and colleagues of the late Lt(N) Pat Cardinell, CD.

**APPLICATION:** The applicant shall provide:

1. A letter requesting the funds with an explanation of career path chosen;

A letter of recommendation from their Corps Commanding Officer with details of the cadets history; and

A letter from either a teacher or principal from the school that the cadet will graduate from.

The awards deadline will be 01 May each year and the successful applicant will be selected by the *Pat Cardinell Scholarship Awards Committee* by 15 May every year with the scholarship being presented at the ACR of the cadet's home corps by a Navy League member.
